Curriculum Overview Year 2 - Term 2



English

This term students will, listen to, read and explore a variety of text types with a specific focus on information texts, simple non-fiction books and narrative texts on similar topics. They will explore how the purpose of a text informs its organisation. Students will investigate the types of words, sentences and punctuation authors use to create an information text.



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Maths

Students will deepen their understanding of number and place value. Concepts relating to data, fractions, addition and subtraction, and counting sequences will be explored. Further number fact strategies will be introduced.

Science

In Science this term, the students will identify celestial objects and describe patterns they observe in the sky. They will use every day and scientific vocabulary to communicate their observations of simple patterns based on experiences.

Health

'Staying Safe - What does this really mean for me?'

Students will:

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* identify and explore skills and strategies to develop respectful relationships.

* identify how different situations influence emotional responses.

* practise strategies they can use when they need to seek, give or deny permission respectfully.

Students will design and create an animal enclosure at a zoo that supports their animal's needs. Students' animal habitats will be built in 4D and show how their selected wild animal interacts in their enclosure. Student will need to consider sustainability of habitats and describe the importance of protecting animal habitats.
